North Carolina concurs with South Carolina's Second Progress Report. The parties have discussed numerous issues with respect to a case management plan. Although there appear to be several areas of agreement, there will also likely be areas of disagreement. North Carolina agrees that further discussion among the parties would be productive and would serve to further narrow the issues of disagreement.

The parties intend to meet telephonically to discuss this matter within the next two weeks. North Carolina agrees that it would be premature to present these issues to the Special Master until the parties have an opportunity to resume their discussions and reduce the scope of disagreements as much as the parties can.
