- Professional behavior, including prompt arrival for every session and business casual attire

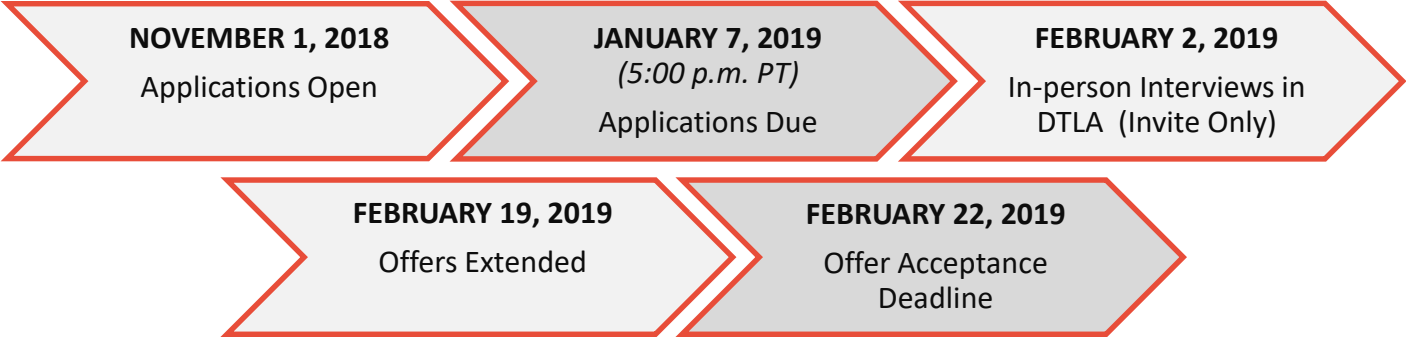
These activities take place in the greater **Los Angeles County area.*
